



Ladder Rules

1. Challenger matches must be played at Bondi Waverley Squash Court between 2 financial members of the squash club
2. There is no particular time of the day or day of the week in which challenge matches must be played
3. Challenge matches must be played 7 days from the date the challenge is issued otherwise the challenged will be deemed to have forfeited
4. Challenge matches are 5 games
5. If a challenge wins they will assume the position of the challenged, with the challenger assuming a place one below their original position.
6. You can challenge only people no more than 10 places above you
7. Exemptions for a challenge
 - i) injury or sickness
 - ii) Away for work or holiday
 - iii) A mutually agreed time cannot be found within 7 days
 - iv) The Challenged already has an existing challenge match within 7 days of the challenge date, in which case the challenge may be accepted with the `14 days of the challenge date
 - v) The challenged has a squash event commitment which conflicts
8. A challenge must be registered with the manager (text, email, phone or messenger) who will contact the challenge and give the challenger's contact details to organise a match day
9. The ladder will be updated on the video screen whenever the manager has been notified of the result on the video screen. The ladder will also be displayed on the website
10. Pennant matches can also count as challenge matches as long as they are played in the correct pennant position and follow the other rules of the ladder
11. Places on the ladder will be used as a basis (but not sole basis) for pennant team selection and position
